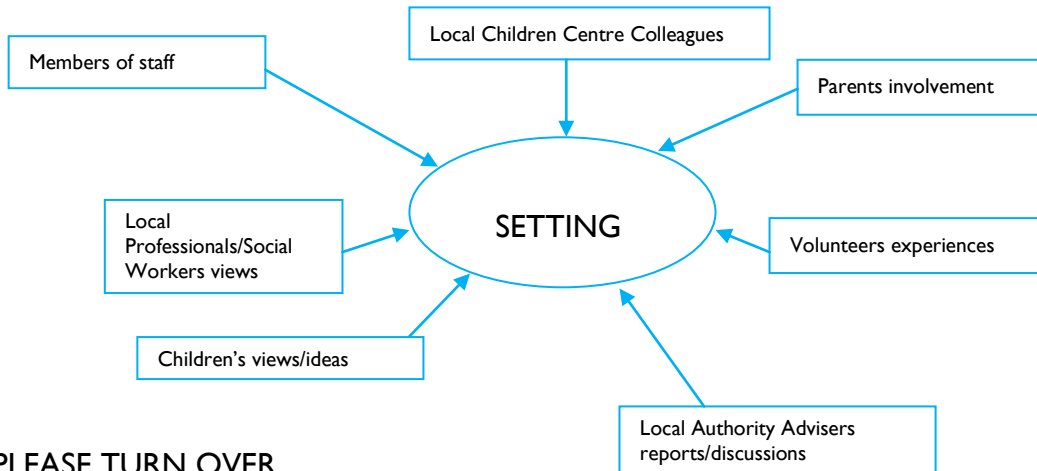


Self-Evaluation
