


Children and young people with physical and/or sensory difficulties might have:

	Visual impairments
	Hearing impairments
	Speech impairments
+ 🚿	Impairments affecting multiple senses, such as having problems with eye sight and hearing

How can schools and colleges help you if you have a physical or sensory difficulty?

Teachers can:



	Teach you braille and touch typing
	Teach you how to be as independent at possible
	Help you move around the school as easily as possible
	Help you communicate and be sociable with others at school
	Give you lessons that use seeing, hearing, smelling, tasting and touching activities
+	Give you extra time to do your school work
	Offer you different ways to do your work, such as using a laptop or a dictaphone
	Check your assistive equipment daily
	Encourage you to take part in after school activities
