# **Occupational Therapy**



	Occupational therapy supports people who have difficulties that prevent them from doing activities that are part of everyday life
Disabled Children's Service	The disabled children's service work with Leicester City Council's specialist occupational therapy team.

## How can the occupational therapy team help?

### They can:

Advise on managing difficulties caused by a disability or loss of ability
Give you equipment and adaptions to support daily living and personal care
Support you moving house if it cannot be adapted

#### Who can use the service?

To use this service the child or young person must:



- Be a child or young person under the age of 18
- Have a permanent or substantial occupational therapy need

Waiting List	If your referral is accepted you will be put on a waiting list to be seen by the occupational therapy team

Plan	A support plan is then made outlining what help can be offered
	If you are happy with the plan it will be put into action
	Whilst waiting for the support offered, you are put on a review list
X	The support plan is checked to make sure progress is made and needs are met
STOP	Once your occupational therapy needs are met the Occupational Therapy team stops working with you
