What to expect, when? Is an excellent resource for parent and carers, providing guidance about a child's learning and development. Information about supporting a child's understanding of language at home is included, spanning all ages and stages.

TASK

Pull some of the suggestions from What to expect, when? that focus on understanding to share with parents e.g.

- Hold my hands to help me make the actions as you sing songs.
- Play games with me where I have to follow instructions like 'roll the ball'
- When we're tidying up give me simple instructions like "Put your shoes in the basket" or "Put the remote control on the sofa."
- When we're sharing a story together ask me why I think something has happened or what might happen next.
