	A DSP is a special unit inside a mainstream school
	It gives children extra help with their learning and needs.
	Children spend time in the DSP and also join mainstream classes, breaks, and activities.
	Each DSP has a focus, like autism, hearing, speech, emotions, or anxiety.
	In a DSP, children learn in small groups or 1:1 with specialist staff.
